Win on Waste Transport Volunteer - Christchurch

Are you passionate about the environment and want to do what you can to help improve it? Yes? Then how about helping us? We are an environmental/waste reduction charity and we are looking for people like you who can help us make a difference.

Currently, we are looking for someone to join our volunteer team and help us transport collected waste, initially every other month as part of a rota, but also to cover holidays, from our community recycling session at the Druitt Hall in Christchurch, to our storage unit which is on the Nuffield Industrial Estate in Poole. The collected waste includes carrier bags containing items such as printer ink cartridges, biscuit wrappers and other similar items that the public donate to us at our monthly Win on Waste sessions held on the first Saturday of each month.

Volunteers in possession of an estate car, or small van may be more suitable for this role, due to the quantity of items involved.

Free parking at the venue is available for the transport volunteer.

Role involves:

- Visiting our Christchurch session at Druitt Hall Christchurch (to assist at the full session if you wish, or just at the end to collect the waste)
- Transporting the waste to our storage unit at the Big Yellow Storage on the Nuffield Industrial Estate in Poole on the day of the session, or in the week following, whichever suits. [Note: The unit is available during office hours (9am-5.30pm on weekdays and Saturdays, 10am-4pm on Sundays) so there is flexibility as to when items can be dropped off].
- Potentially working alone in loading/unloading collected waste, guided by our lone working policy.
- To safely store items in the unit, and notify Stacey, the Business Manager, once items have been dropped off.

Benefits to you:

- knowing you are helping a small environmental charity make a difference.
- increasing your knowledge about the work of charities like Win on Waste and potentially increasing your own skills-base and portfolio at the same time.
- the possibility of us writing a reference for you if needed in the future.

Benefits to Win on Waste:

- We will have the reassurance that your work will help us to be more efficient.
- We know that volunteers often come with ideas as well as skills which they would like to share with us.

Time commitment: approximately 4 hours per month, depending on whether you attend the full session.
